Adonna Thomas, 69, passed away on May 7, 2017 in Brownwood, Texas.

Adonna was born on May 28, 1947, in Sacramento, California to Lois Loree (Decker) and James Brumley. She spent her high school years in San Saba, before returning to California and attending college in Ventura County. Her daughter, Julie Anne Freyman, was born in Portsmouth, New Hampshire, while her then-husband was overseas, during the Vietnam War.

Adonna's professional career was based upon her financial and bookkeeping skills, taking her from banking to financial management to her most significant career step with ComputerLand Corporationinventor of computer retailing and franchising, in the early 1980s. She rose to management of the company's dealer and franchisee relations, responsible for vendor fairs and convention management, all over the U.S.

She retired in 1995, returning to San Saba to care for her widowed father, James Brumley who was a disabled World War II veteran. She married Jerry Thomas of Brady, Texas in 2003. He died in an automobile crash in 2009. She remained in San Saba with her father, who died in 2013. Her last years in San Saba were largely dominated by grief and illness, all of which evaporated as she went to be with Jerry and The Lord on Sunday, May 7, 2017.

She leaves behind her daughter, Julie Anne Freyman and husband Keith of Thousand Oaks, California; her sister April Fiur and husband Henry of Lampasas, Texas.
