Mrs. Aurora Frances Argo, 81 of Lampasas, Texas passed away on March 24, 2021 in Woodruff, South Carolina. She was born in Lampasas, Texas to Jose and Damiana Lopez Maldonado on March 22, 1940. She married Gary Warner "Victor" Argo in Temple, Texas on March 17, 1961.

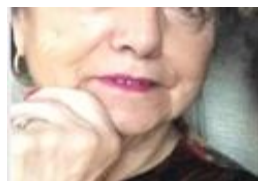
