July 7, 1929 - March 2, 2016

Beatrice (BeBee) Joy Kordzik Faught passed from this life to be with her God and Saviour on Wednesday, March 2, 2016, at the age of 86 years and 7 months, while at her home of over 60 years, surrounded by members of the family she so deeply loved. In the weeks prior to her death she enjoyed reminiscing with her family about their time together as well as her memories of her childhood and youth.

BeBee was born on July 7, 1929 in Fredericksburg, Texas to Edgar and Margaret (Zoeller) Kordzik. She grew up as the only child of this farm family during the Great Depression. She and her parents faced many obstacles and setbacks during this time, as did many others. Her childhood influenced her work ethic, as well as her love for family and others, for the remainder of her life. Upon graduation from Fredericksburg High School in 1947, she attended and graduated in 1950 from the Brackenridge School of Nursing in Austin, Texas as a Registered Nurse. During her nursing school years, she met and dated the man who would become her devoted husband and best friend for the next 65 years. Shortly after her graduation, BeBee married Elton Faught in Fredericksburg, Texas on August 20, 1950. It was at this time she and Elton moved to San Saba, Texas where she began her nursing career at the San Saba Memorial Hospital, working as a RN, caring for many patients and touching many lives. It was during these years, as well, that she and Elton began their family. Debra was born in 1951 followed by Susan, who died in infancy in 1956, and Stephen, who was born in 1958. She continued her

nursing career at San Saba Memorial Hospital by teaching a LVN Nursing School for several years, again having a positive, long term, influence on her students and community. In the early 1970's, BeBee worked for Hill Country Community Action as the Regional Director of Family Planning. Then, in 1976, she and Elton bought and operated Community Appliance for many years until they retired in 1999. During this time, they were blessed to enjoy a number of trips throughout the world as a result of their sales success as Whirlpool Appliance dealers. BeBee was a devoted member of New Hope Primitive Baptist Church in Fredericksburg, Texas where loved to worship and hear of her Saviour as well as having sweet fellowship with both the young and old in the church.

BeBee enjoyed her life to its fullest. Over the years, she was active in her professional life as well as having membership and leadership roles in various clubs and organizations. She and Elton took great joy in attending and keeping up with the various sporting events and other activities of their children, then grandchildren, and then great-grandchildren. She was an active home maker and enjoyed cooking, needlepoint, and caring for others and always making sure that anyone who entered her home was made to be comfortable and to feel welcomed.

BeBee was preceded in death by her parents; Edgar and Margaret Kordzik and her daughter; Susan Elaine. She is survived by her loving husband, Elton Faught, and their children; Debbie Shahan and husband Keith, and Steve Faught and wife Karen. She is also survived by her grandchildren; Bryan Shahan and wife Bonnie, Kevin Shahan and wife Monica, Nathan Shahan and wife Shawna, Jason Shahan and wife Desiree, Stephen Shahan and wife Marci, Reagan Faught and wife Stephanie, Mitchell Faught and wife Katie, Cynthia Faught, Brandon Stafford and wife Ginger and Kendall Stafford. She also leaves 17 great-grandchildren and 2 great-great- grandchildren as a

reminder of her legacy of love. In addition, she is survived by her brother-in-law, Jim Faught of Doss, Texas.

Serving as Pallbearers are her grandsons.
