Which began a long tradition in the neighborhood. It grew to be a potluck and included a number of the neighbors. Ben was a major contributor to the event he would cook his signature macaroni and cheese, fried cabbage, nachos and other delicious treats. A big part of Beer Monday was the Beer. It became a beer tasting event. Ben would check the larger beer stores looking for new unusual beers for us to sample. We would do the same and then we would sample our finds. Remembering those days reminds me of some of Ben's favorites: Jester King Farmhouse Ale, Harry Eyeball, Chicken Killer, Devils Backbone and the ultimate Dog Fish Head 120. Of course Ben always wanted his old standby Keystone Ice. When they stopped selling it in Austin we stopped at Dollar Generals wherever we went to buy Ben some Beer. We spent a lot of time talking and hearing about the concerts Ben would go to. We even figured out that Ben and I went to the same Rolling Stone Concert in San Antonio in 1975 before we knew each other. Beer Mondays fell to the wayside when covid hit. We all took it hard, especially Ben. He was a True Friend and we will miss him always. Lord, we Pray that you take care of Ben in Heaven with Heavy Metal Music and Keystone Ice.
