Blanche Eudell Biggs passed away peacefully in San Saba, Tx, on April 7, 2017 at the age of 88.

She loved caring for others and will be remembered as a kind hearted and loving person. She loved to read and loved going to auctions and

buying collectibles and antiques. She was a member of the Church of Christ of Latter Day Saints.

She is survived by her sister, Linda Harvell of San Saba, two brothers, Kenneth Cook of Goldthwaite and J.D. Cook and wife, Shirley, of San Angelo; and one sister-in-law, Ruby Cook of Goldthwaite.
