Clyde Faught, 91, passed away on October 16, 2012, in New Braunfels, Texas. Visitation will be held at Heritage Funeral Home San Saba at 12:30-2:00 PM on Saturday, October 20, 2012, with services to follow at 2:00 PM. Interment will be in the China Creek Cemetery.

Clyde Faught was born on April 11, 1921 to Alonzo and Mary Baethge Faught in Doss, Texas. He often led the singing there until his health prevented him from attending.
