Coleman Wesley "C.W." Cox Sr., 79, of San Saba, Texas passed away on Wednesday, January 9, 2013, in San Saba. Graveside services will be held on Saturday, January 12, 2013, at 10:00 a.m., at the Richland Springs Cemetery in Richland Springs, Texas.

C.W. was born on February 24, 1933, in Alpine, Texas, to Coleman Foster Cox Jr. and Mary (White) Cox. He married Mary Katherine Roberds on May 30, 1953, in Richland Springs. He was a member of the First United Methodist Church in Sanderson, Texas.
