Conley Addison Purcell, 87, of Brady, Texas, passed away Sunday, June 10, 2012, in Brady. Visitation is from 6:00 to 8:00 p.m. on Tuesday, June 12, 2012 at Heritage Funeral Home. Funeral services will be held Wednesday, June 13, 2012, at 2:00 p.m. at Sunset Ridge Church of Christ in Brady with interment at Rest Haven Cemetery.

Conley was born in Red Rock, Texas, on July 8, 1924, to Samuel Jefferson and Olive (Murchison) Purcell. He married Eloise Brown in Voca, Texas, on November 25, 1950 and they were married for 55 years at the time of her death in 2006.

Mr. Purcell was a lifelong resident of McCulloch County. He was known by most people as the longtime "parts man" for John Deere Tractor in Brady and was also a rancher for many years. He was a lifetime member of the Texas Sheep & Goat Raisers Association and the Veterans of Foreign Wars; having been a member of the US Navy. He was a member of the Sunset Ridge Church of Christ.
