David Mark Kolodziej, 56, of Lampasas, passed away on Sunday April 16, 2023 at his home in Lampasas.

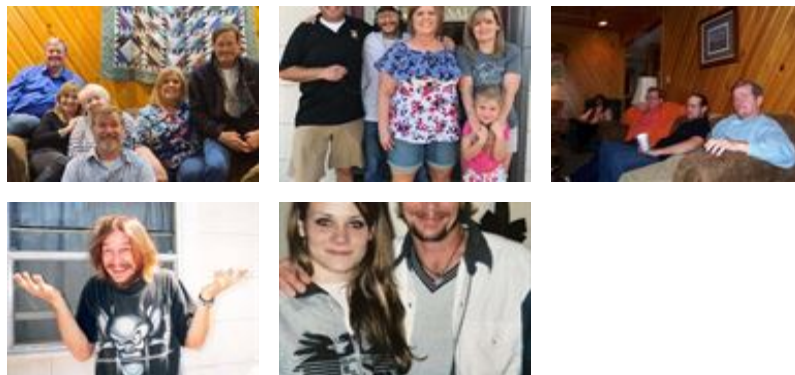
