Domingo Duarte Botello 92, of San Saba Texas Passed Away on Thursday August 13, 2020. He was born in Pasche, Texas to Crisostomo España Botello and Maria De Jesus Duarte on February 19, 1928.

Domingo spent much of his youth in and around San Saba working on the family farm but moved to Augusta, Georgia, at 23 when he was drafted into the Army. He remained in Georgia at Camp Gordon for 2 years as part of the signal corps and returned to San Saba after being honorably discharged.
