Donna Lee Geller, 70, of Menard, Texas went home to be with the lord in June 2023 at her home in Menard, Texas.

Anyone could literally spot her at any distance or through any crowd. She continued to live in Camp Wood for several years. For a time, she ran STAR Video in Camp Wood and locals had many fond memories there. But eventually she was called to Junction, TX in 2001. She had developed a strong church family and felt led to be with them. Donna worked for several businesses including Isaac's, Milky Way, and the Hill Country Care Center where she was the dietary supervisor. Donna was known to be a great boss and manager. She was a very hard worker, working several jobs at once sometimes to take care of herself and her children. She did live in Frisco for a brief 2-year period but then moved right back to

Junction. Donna loved the strong community and the wholehearted friendships she had made there and couldn't stay away. Circumstances eventually brought her to Menard where she helped take care of her parents when they became elderly, and she's lived there for the past 11 years.
