November 18, 1924 - October 27, 2015

Georgia Mae McWilliams passed away on October 27, 2015, in Weatherford, Texas at the age of 90.

Georgia Mae Fiedler McWilliams was born in Shiner, TX, on November 18, 1924, to George and Emma Draeger Fiedler. She had two younger brothers: Gene Fiedler and Clifton Fiedler. She graduated Shiner High School in 1942 and married Elroy "Mac" McWilliams on October 21, 1944. When Mac retired from Mobil Oil Co. in 1983, they moved to Brady because it was near Katemcy TX, where Mac grew up and family property there. They restored a 1900's Craftsman-style home in Brady and furnished it with antiques they had collected for 30 years. Her husband preceded her in death in 2011.

Her hobby for many years was raising African Violets and she won numerous prizes in flower show competitions. She also served as an officer in the Dallas, TX and Brownwood, TX African Violet Societies.
