Glen O. Ratliff, 81, passed away at his ranch on July 10, 2024. Glen was born on April 12, 1943, in San Angelo to Fadie F. and Inez Maxine Quirl Ratliff. He was raised in Zephyr and attended Zephyr ISD. Glen was a member of the Zion Lutheran Church in Priddy, Texas.

Glen joined the U.S. Army in January 1961 and served in the Vietnam War. After proudly serving his country, Glen was employed by Phillips Driscopipe, Holley Chevrolet, the State School and the Santa Fe Railway. In retirement, Glen followed his passion as a full-time rancher.

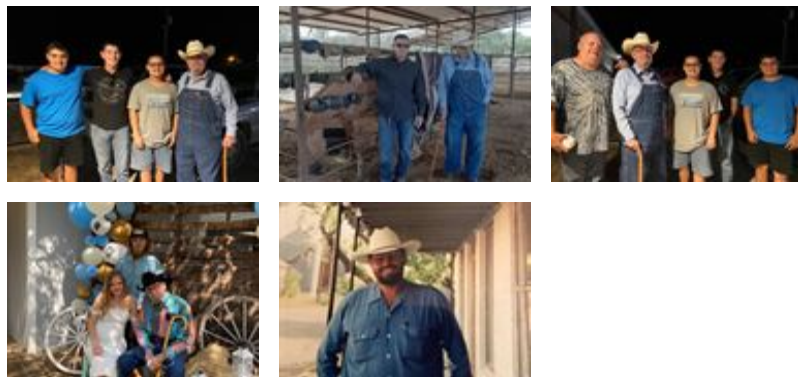
