Jack Catron, 78, of Menard, Texas, went home to be with the Lord on Dec. 18, 2021.

Jack was born November 5, 1943 in Glendale, Ohio to Wilford and Dessie Mae Catron. He graduated from Lamphere High School in Madison Heights, Michigan, and went on to pursue a career in drafting and engineering.
