



Jimmy Ed Locklear

November 25, 1945 - September 11, 2023

James Edward (Jimmy Ed) Locklear, 77, passed away peacefully on September 11, 2023, at his home near Brady. He was born in El Reno, Oklahoma on November 25, 1945, to Edward Gray Locklear and Margaret (Clark) Locklear. At the age of 2 weeks, he moved with his parents back to his dad's hometown of Voca after his dad's discharge from the Army.

Jimmy spent 2 years in the army, serving most of that time in Germany in the postal department. He worked for the Texas Highway Department in the engineering division, then for Durst Ford Tractor, and then spent nearly 30 years driving the propane truck for Brady Butane. He also did custom farming, and raised cattle, goats, and sheep.

He enjoyed deer hunting, and watching his grandchildren in their activities.

Jimmy was preceded in death by his parents.

Jimmy is survived by Connie, his wife of 54 years, his son Ronnie Locklear and wife Audrey of Stephenville, his daughter Lesa Feldhousen and husband Lance of College Station, two granddaughters Layne Feldhousen and Logen Feldhousen, and grandson James Grey Locklear. Also surviving is his sister Susan Neal of Brady.

Visitation will be held from 6:00 - 8:00 PM Friday September 15, 2023, at Heritage Funeral Home in Brady.

Funeral Service will be at 10:00 AM Saturday September 16, 2023, at Heritage Funeral Home in Brady with Gaylon Morris, officiating. Burial will be at Rest Haven Cemetery.

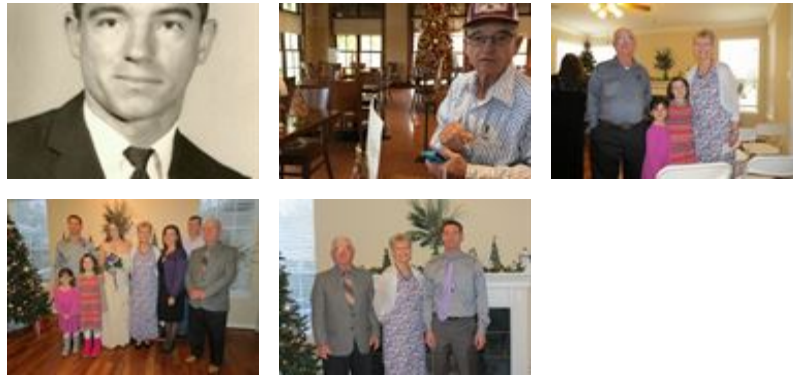
