Jim Bob Roddie, age 58, passed away on Sunday, September 5, 2021, in Kerrville.

Jim was born on March 24, 1963, in Brady, Texas to Bill and Mary Francis (Finlay) Roddie. He married Sterling Davenport on January 1, 1996, in Lake Tahoe, and they spent 25 years in life, laughter, family and love.

Jim was a 1981 graduate of Brady High School. He was a proud alumnus of Texas Tech University where he obtained his Masters Degree in 1987. He joined the Peace Corps in 1989 and went to Botswana for two years before returning to Brady to start Roddie Trucking with his brother Buzz. He continued that endeavor before going into Nursing Home Administration with Shuffield. He served his community as President of the Brady Chamber of Commerce and as President of Brady Youth Sports. He was a lifetime resident of Brady.

Above all else, Jim was a Christian man and a member of the First Christian Church. He was a loving husband, the best "girl dad" ever, and a doting grandfather.

Jim was preceded in death by his parents and a niece, Amie.
