



Jimmie Doran Shahan

April 18, 1928 - August 25, 2017

Jimmie D. Shahan, lifelong resident of San Saba County, passed away on Friday, August 25, 2017 peacefully in the presence of his wife.

Jimmie was born on April 18, 1928 to Horace and Linnie (Wood) Shahan on the Mark Oliver Place in San Saba County. He attended grammar school at Pecan Grove School, finishing 7th grade and going directly into San Saba High School graduating in 1945. Jimmie and his brother, Roy, were in the Golden Gloves Boxing. After graduation, he continued to assist his dad on the ranch and worked for Texaco Company owned by Jack Owens and William Kuykendall. On January 2, 1947 he married Marjorie Lone Taylor. In 1949 Jimmie and his brother, Roy bought the Huckabee Auto Parts store. In 1995 he sold his interest in the store to his brother, Roy. Later he went into partnership with Bill Dyer at Centex Fuel for a few years. After selling his partnership, he continued to Ranch and drove delivering vehicles for Golding Motors and Heart of Texas Ford in Brady until he retired. Jimmie and Marjorie raised five children and were married for 54 years before she passed away.

In 2002, God brought Jimmie and Adriane McIntosh Brown together. They were married September 21, 2002. The first year of their marriage, they had the blessing of having their granddaughter Shayna Jo live with them. They enjoyed their life together and were best friends. Family was his pride and joy and he loved taking care of and playing with his grandchildren and great-grandchildren. Especially teaching them golf and attending their sporting

events. He served on the San Saba City Council, San Saba ISD School Board, City Zoning Board, Heart of Texas Baptist Encampment Board as well as being Chairman of Deacons and Sunday School Teacher of Pecan Grove Baptist church. He was ordained as deacon in 1966 and served actively until July 2014. He attended First Baptist Church from December 2014 until July 16, 2017 as his health permitted. Jimmie was avid golfer. He qualified and represented seniors in Senior Olympics placing second in the State of Texas. He coached little league Baseball and announced many football and baseball games. He was a great left-handed pitcher.

Jimmie lived life to the fullest. Jimmie was a wonderful Christian example and loved his family with all his heart. He was known for his integrity, kindness, character, love for God, gentleness, and always was lending a helping hand to those in need.
