John W. Bucy, 85, of Brady, Texas, passed away Monday, July 1, 2013, in Brady. Visitation will be held on Tuesday, July 2, 2013, from 6 - 8 pm at Heritage Funeral Home in Brady. Funeral services will be held at 10:00 a.m., Wednesday, July 3, 2013, at Heritage Funeral Home Chapel with burial to follow at Rest Haven Cemetery.

John was born on March 29, 1928, in Paris, Tennessee, to John Elvis Bucy and Ruby Chilcutt Bucy. He served two years in the US Army during the Korean War. He had served terms on the City Council and had been Mayor of the City of Brady in the early 1980's. He also owned Rainbow Realty and had been a rental property owner for years. John had been a long-time member of the Lion's Club and was a Christian.
