John Jeffrey Runyon, 64, of Lampasas, Texas died at his residence on Monday, August 2, 2021. He was born on Wednesday, February 20, 1957, in Muncie, Indiana to Edward and Norma Sue Losh Runyon. Mr. Runyon had lived in Lampasas since 1983, moving here from Austin, having spent his childhood in Indiana.
