Lena Marguerite Peavy Horton Spinks made her final journey in this life to her Heavenly home on October 31, 2020, at the age of 100 years, 10 months, and 16 days after succumbing to COVID-19. She lived her life to the fullest while preparing for the day her Lord would call her home.

A graveside service and burial will be held on Thursday, November 5, 2020, at 1:00 p.m. She will be laid to rest at Rest Haven Cemetery in Menard alongside her Peavy family.

Lena was born December 15, 1919, the eighth child to Charles Edward and Pharo Sarah Peavy in the Ellis Community in Menard County, Texas. She attended school in the one-room Ellis Schoolhouse in Menard through 11th grade.

Lena was a lifelong member of the Church of Christ, and she loved her church and her fellow church members. She considered them to be her family. Her close friend and former pastor, Mike Riley, will officiate her final service.
