Mark Foster, age 66 of Brady, Texas passed away Wednesday, May 20, 2015 at his home in Brady.

He was born October 1, 1948 in Houston, Texas a son of Marvin F. Foster, Jr. and JoAnn (Vento) Hawthorne.
