Marston Earl "Uncle Moss" Seward, 88, of Brady, Texas, passed away Saturday, November 9, 2013, in Brady. Graveside services will be held at 2 p.m., Monday, November 11, 2013, at Rest Haven Cemetery with burial to follow. Arrangements made under the direction of Heritage Funeral Home in Brady.

Marston was born on August 4, 1925, in Rochelle, Texas, to John Thomas Seward and Effie V. (Jeffreys) Seward. He served two years with the US Navy during World War II. He made a career as an electrical engineer for the Western Electric division of AT&T and traveled the world with his work. He had visited 34 foreign countries by the time he retired and had even lived in Italy for three years. Marston moved back to Brady from North Carolina in 1981. "Moss", as he was known by his friends, enjoyed gardening and loved to cook. He was well known for his candy making - especially around holiday time. He would have numerous requests for batches of his homemade peanut brittle, divinity and fudge, and was even known to tempt his dentist with platters of homemade candy.

He was preceded in death by; his parents; two brothers; Vernon Seward and Edward Seward; and one niece; Judy Seward.
