Mauro Duarte Botello, 81, passed away on April 25, 2023, in Fort Worth, Texas

He was born to Crisostimo E Botello and Maria de Jesus(Jesusita) Duarte, on November 30, 1941, in O'Donell, Texas.

He was the youngest of 12 brothers and sisters. The family moved to San Saba when he was 2. He was a baseball pitcher growing up and was considered one of the best in the area. He lived, in San Saba, until he moved, to Fort Worth, in 1967, with his wife Zoila and son Michael. He went to work, as a Dairy worker, for R.J. Smelley Dairy, in Fort Worth. He later divorced but continued to work, at this dairy, for over 40 years, until he retired.

He loved sports and closely followed the local High School football team, from Aledo. He loved the Texas Rangers baseball team and rarely missed watching their games. He also enjoyed watching the Dallas Cowboys, Dallas Mavericks, and Dallas Stars games. He loved working in his vegetable garden, looking after his son's rabbits, and feeding and watching the birds, at his garden.

His favorite pastime was sitting, on his chair, at his garden, and receiving visitors. He loved talking with everyone and sharing his vegetables, telling you

about his birds and sharing good conversation.

He is survived by his brothers Thomas Botello, from Lubbock, and Felix Botello, from San Saba, and his sister Pauline Perez, from San Saba, and his son, Michael Botello, from Fort Worth.

He was preceded in death, by his mother Maria de Jesus(Jesusita) Duarte and father Crisostimo E Botello, sister Santos Ramirez, and brothers G.D. Botello, John Botello, Chris Botello, Joe Botello, Simon Botello, T.D Botello, and Domingo Botello
