Michael Duane Hoozer, age 70, of Lampasas, passed away on 15th of May 2023.

Born in Beaumont in 1952, to Bryant Earl Hoozer and Hazel Lucille Smith, Mike was the baby of the family's 10 kids. In his youth, Mike worked in stockyards, rode bulls in the rodeo and narrowly lost by decision in the 1971 Texas Golden Gloves Championship. The newspapers documented the crowd's disappointment with the decision. Mike worked for boilermaker's local #587 until his retirement after some 30 years of service. He loved the beach, riding the back roads looking for deer and his family.

Most of all, many will remember his sense of humor and his loving heart.

Michael is survived by his brothers Earl M. Hoozer, Bill Hoosier and wife Linda; sisters, Lavon Woods, Lanelle Jordon and husband, James; son, Marshall Hoozer and wife Tahlia; five grandchildren, Gemma, Henry, Willem, Roman and Remi; and the numerous nieces and nephews he loved.
