Mildred Virginia (Means) Jones, 90, passed away on Friday, June 24, 2016 in Brownwood, Texas.

Mildred was born on October 3, 1925, the fourth of five daughters born to Della Virginia Stevenson Means and Edward Franklin Means, in the Colony community located in San Saba County, Texas.

Mildred grew up on the family farm, her mother being widowed when Mildred was just a child. She attended school first at the small Colony community school, then San Saba High School. She married Charles Wilborn Jones just prior to his deployment to Europe to fight in the invasion of Europe during World War II. After the war, Mildred and Charles made their home in San Antonio, Tx. After Charles was severely injured in a workplace accident, they moved to Mills County, where Mildred worked to support the family, first at Woody's Drug Store in Goldthwaite, then as a bookkeeper for many years for Don Geeslin Farms. Mildred was a dedicated mother and grandmother to her two children and four grandchildren. For the last years of her life, due to severe health problems, she lived at Oakridge Manor nursing home in Brownwood, where she was cared for by the outstanding nurses and care technicians there.

Mildred was a hard working woman, and a gifted seamstress and gardener. No project was too hard for her to tackle. She made many a Halloween costume for her granddaughters.
