Mitzi graduated from Menard High School in 1961 in three years' time. She was a twirler and elected football queen her senior year. She also participated in One-Act play and went to state.

After high school, she went to Angelo State University, where she was a member of the Ramettes dance team. She then transferred to Texas Tech University, where she earned a degree in family Home Economics. Mitzi taught elementary school in Lubbock, Austin, and Houston for 37 years. She was a favorite teacher to many, and she loved keeping up with former students.

Mitzi is survived by her children Brandi Nelson (husband Jeff), Kendall Rabon, and Zachary Rabon, sister Candace Rodmon and brother and sister-in-law Bill and Susan Lehne.
