She devoted 51 years of her life to taking great care of him. They had one daughter Su Ransom Carlile. They moved the family, house and all, from Menard, to a small farm in Junction where they settled and established a prize-winning pecan orchard.

Patsy was proud of her wonderful pecans and many people were able to enjoy them in her baking. Although she stayed busy, she always had time for friends to stop by for a visit. No one ever left empty handed or with an empty stomach.

Patsy was as good at baking, sewing, or gardening as she was cutting wood or fixing a broken-down car. She also took the Master Naturalist class in her 70's and loved helping out in the community with these projects. She was a

member of the First Baptist Church in Junction and very active when possible.

Patsy is preceded in death by her parents, her husband Lewis, and both of her brothers Douglas and Roger Phillips.
