Some years after Gene's death in 1988, she met LT Mick who became her partner and traveled/lived in numerous places in the US winding up in Kempner Texas.

She was the office manager for the Bradley Insurance Agency in Granbury, Texas for many years. While in Kempner, she came out of retirement to become the City Secretary and Administrative Judge. 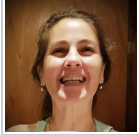
