He and Sue loved to cook and could often be found lovingly bickering about what seasoning a certain dish needed. He was active in the community volunteering as a fireman and EMS, coaching Little League and acting as president of the San Saba Booster Club. When he went anywhere, he always longed to be back home, and we know he is now reunited with the love of his life in his forever home. 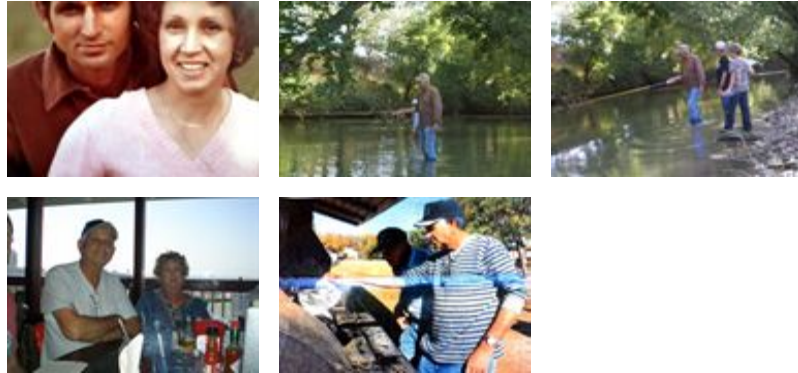
