Ruby Sloan, 99, of San Saba, passed away on Monday, October 22, 2012. Services will be held on Thursday, October 25, 2012, at 10:00 AM at the New Hope Presbyterian Church in the Sloan community of San Saba County. Dr. John Davenport will officiate the services.
