Shirley Ann Sanders Burns, 79, went to be with the Lord on July 30th in San Angelo.

The funeral service will on Monday, August 5, 2024, at Immanuel Baptist Church in San Angelo at 11 am with Pastor Ryan Buck officiating. Internment will be at a later date at East Lawn Memorial Park in Early, TX.

Shirley was born in Atlanta, GA on March 29, 1945, the first of three daughters to Watson Sanders and Mary Pearl Hatcher Sanders. She grew up in Warner Robbins, GA where she graduated from high school in 1963. She was married to Jack Wayne Burns, a Southern Baptist pastor on December 16, 1972 in Reedley, CA.
