Shirley Annette Tedder was born on August 3, 1942 in San Saba, Texas and passed away quietly in her home in Mason, Texas on July 30, 2022 from a life long-lived.

She was the daughter of Phila Farr McNair born in Granger, Texas and Reeve Olin McNair born in Comal County. Annette was an only child who spent most of her childhood days either fishing, hunting or riding horses along the Colorado River at Waldrip, Texas.

Annette married her husband, Jerry Tedder in Lohn, Texas on December 31, 1964. They were married for 47 years and had 3 children they raised on the family farm in East Sweden, Texas. She instilled strong work ethics, family values and always faith in God in her family. She shared love and laughter with her friends and family on a daily basis.
