BRASINGTON, Thomas "Tommy" Gordan Jr, 43 years young was born April 11, 1978 and died on January 23, 2022, after a courageous fight with COVID-19. Currently of Lampasas TX, and formerly of Fort Polk Louisiana where he proudly served as an Army Staff Sergeant in the 1st Battalion (Airborne), 509th Infantry. Tommy was a graduate of Springfield High School in Holland, OH, Class of 96. He attended Nyack College, NY receiving his bachelor's degree in Youth Ministry in 2002, where he also played in two Baseball NCCAA World Series. He later received his second bachelor's degree as an Information Technology Specialist with the United States Army, followed by his master's degree in Technology Management at Trident University (Summa Cum Laude).
