Thomas Lloyd Womack Jr. of San Angelo, TX left this world on October 20th, 2024. Tom Womack was born in Brownwood, TX on February 17th, 1944 to Thomas Lloyd Womack Sr. and Mary Lois (Newman) Womack. Tom grew up in Brownwood, graduating from Brownwood High School in 1962. He went on to attend Howard Payne University, earning a degree in Business Administration in 1965.
