Una Ione Oliver, 89, passed away peacefully in her sleep, Friday morning, November 25, 2022. Una was born January 2, 1933, to Earl M. Offutt and Virgaline Harter Offutt in Pine Bluff, Arkansas, the fifth of seven children. As a young adult in Pine Bluff, Una worked for Metropolitan Insurance company and met her future husband Ray when her older brother, Bud invited him home for dinner. She was a member of the First Presbyterian Church for many years and found fulfillment in the groups and Bible studies there, especially after Raymond passed in

2007. She was especially proud when she became an Elder of the Church.
