Virginia Ann Moseley, age 69, of Rochelle, Texas, went to be with her Lord and Saviour on December 13, 2022.

She was born April 4, 1953 in Coleman, TX. She was a graduate of Coleman High School in 1971 and went on to graduate from Texas Tech University with her master's degree in education in 1975. 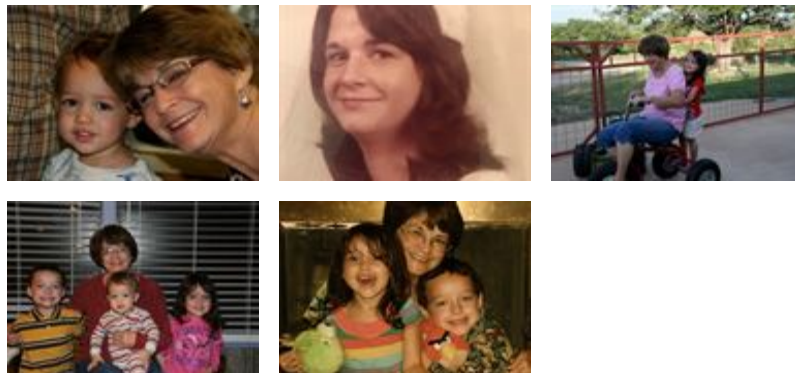
