Sgt. William Collier served our county for 25 years. He served several tours of duty in Vietnam where his distinguished service was reflected by The Silver Star, The Bronze Star with Valor, The Purple Heart with Two Oak Leaf Clusters, The Combat Infantry Badge, The Vietnamese Cross of Gallantry, and numerous Army commendation awards. As an Army Ranger, he received The Combat Assault Commendation and was a Master Paratrooper. He also served in Germany and his last assignment was with the Pentagon just prior to his retirement in 1987. Sgt. Collier never passed an American flag without a heartfelt salute representative of his intense love of county! His passing so close to America's birthday was symbolic of a soldier going Home. 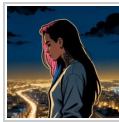

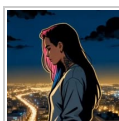
