William Allen "Bill" Perdue, 79, of Ingram, Texas, passed away on December 1, 2014, in Ingram, Texas.

Services will be at 2:00 p.m. on Friday December 5th, 2014, at Heritage Funeral Home Chapel in Menard, interment will follow at Rest Haven Cemetery.
