Walter Woodrow Wilson Riggs, 95, of San Saba, joined the Lord on Tuesday, November 7, 2017.

Woodrow was born on December 22, 1921 to George Samuel and Katie Howard Riggs in San Saba, Texas. Woody served in the Coast Guard during WWII with several actions in the Phillipines among other areas. Woody married June Elizabeth Summers on September 14, 1946 in San Saba. He retired from Lone Star Gas Company after 34 years in 1983. He was a natural athlete playing football, baseball and a Golden Gloves Boxer besides taking up golf at the age of 51.
